

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<p>FEEDBACK & EVALUTATIONS</p>	<p>Anaesthesia Safety vs. Aviation Safety:</p> <p>Dr. Paranjape drew a compelling analogy comparing anaesthesia care to aviation. Both demand precision, constant vigilance, and quick decision-making in high-stakes environments. He pointed out:</p> <p>Pilots and anaesthesiologists both work in life-critical systems where minor oversights can lead to major disasters. Aviation has benefited from standardized checklists, simulation-based training, and a non-punitive error-reporting culture, leading to exceptional safety records.</p> <p>In anaesthesia, crisis simulation, routine safety checks, and team communication protocols must be implemented just as rigorously to prevent complications and improve outcomes.</p>
