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

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

Apply the RCRI scoring system to assess cardiac risk in patients undergoing non-cardiac surgery. Interpret RCRI scores to guide pre-operative clinical decisions and patient management. Recognize the limitations of RCRI and consider additional risk factors when necessary. Integrate RCRI into routine pre-operative evaluation protocols to improve patient outcomes.


understanding. Overall, it was an engaging session that added
