- III. To identify the six independent predictors of cardiac risk used in RCRI.
- IV. To evaluate how RCRI is applied in clinical decision-making before non-cardiac surgery.
- V. To discuss the clinical utility, strengths, and limitations of the RCRI tool.
- VI. To enhance the ability to predict and manage perioperative cardiac complications effectively.
